Enochs High School Sports Information

Parent / Player Information Night- Wednesday, June 19, 2019 Enochs HS Cafeteria – 5:00pm

- Fall sports information – including official athletic start dates, practice information & schedules, try-out schedules, game schedules, paperwork requirements, and more.
- Bring your Medical Insurance Card to get your MCS Accident Insurance Certification Waiver Form (green form) signed-off in front of staff coaches who must witness parent signatures and sign the forms.
- Policies and participation requirements will be covered. NEW FOR 2017-18: Electronic sports packets MUST be completed, with accident waiver & physical before athletic practice activity! NO Exceptions!
- Attendance at this event is very important and will help guide you and your athlete through the process of playing sports at the high school level.

Sports Physicals Day – ALL Athletes, ALL Sports Thursday, June 20, 2019 Davis HS GYM – 1:30pm–3:00pm

Sports physicals for Enochs Athletics – Fall / Winter / Spring – One Day Only

- Sports Physicals for Enochs Athletics – Fall * Winter * Spring – One Day Only
- This is the only sports physical time for the entire school year, do not miss out, attend this event!
- Boys and girls will be assessed on site; a health history will be taken.
- Sports Physical Location: Davis HS Gymnasium – 1200 West Rumble Rd.
- Physicals will only be done from 1:30pm-3:00pm, do not be late!
- A parent MUST attend with you to sign required forms or have already signed it at the sports information night on the 19th.
- COST: \$25.00 (All proceeds donated back to MCS Athletics from DMC; **Checks can be made out to “DMC”**)

Requirements

- **Athletes:** Must bring glasses, contacts, medications and/or inhalers.
- **Parents:** A parent must be present to sign the medical paperwork or have already signed it at the sports information night on the 19th.
Make sure students are **well hydrated**... avoid all caffeine and “energy” drinks the day of the sports physical (drastically affects blood pressure).

Instructions for Registering Your Athlete

SportsNet, Inc. provides secure online registration services for high school athletic programs. Instructions for creating a parent/guardian user account and registering one or more athletes are below.

Creating an Account

1. Go to the website listed above for your school
2. Click the Create an Account link near the bottom of the screen
3. Enter the required information and submit the form
4. Log in to the system with your email address and password
5. Follow the instructions inside the system

Before You Begin

Make sure you have the following prior to attempting to register your child:

- Your child's student identification number.
- The exact spelling of your student's first and last name as it appears in official school records.
- A scanned copy of your child's Pre-Participation Sports Physical Exam completed by a physician **AFTER JUNE 10, 2019** downloaded to your computer (to be uploaded during registration). If your athlete attends Sports Physical day on July 27th (and is cleared), this information will be uploaded for you.
- Your child's health insurance coverage information, including the name of the provider and the policy ID.

Important

The school will not receive your submission until you complete the entire process, ending with your final electronic signature on the last available screen. Be sure to check your email for a confirmation message after you have finished.

Final Athletic Clearance to Participate in Athletics

- Before your athlete is cleared & the online registration is complete, parents must sign the Accident Insurance Certificate Waiver (green form) at the school site, in the presence of a school official (This may be done at the Parent Info Night on June 19th or in the SBO) and have health insurance in place, School health insurance forms are available & payment may be made in the SBO.
- Once the above requirements are met, students must receive their "Clearance ticket" (aka "The Golden Ticket") in the SBO. This clearance ticket is given to your coach to indicate you are cleared to participate in your sport.
- Due to football and water polo practice beginning on July 19th and 29th – **FOOTBALL AND WATER POLO PLAYERS WILL BE CLEARED IN THE SBO ON MONDAY JULY 22ND THROUGH WEDNESDAY JULY 23RD OTHERWISE THEY WILL HAVE TO WAIT UNTIL JULY 30TH.**
- All other fall sports start practice on Monday, August 5th – Non-football/water polo Fall athletes will be cleared in the SBO on Thursday, July 30th and beyond. SBO hours (7:30am – 3:30pm; closed from 12:30pm – 1:00pm).
- **YOU MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN YOUR SPORT UNTIL YOU ARE FULLY CLEARED!!**

Registration Process

- Be sure to carefully read the instructions on each screen and provide all required information. If you are unable to finish in a single session, the information you have already submitted will be saved and you can log back in at a later time to finish.
