**Student Orientation Advising and Registration (SOAR)** will take place July 28<sup>th</sup> – July 30<sup>th</sup>. Attendance is required for all students prior to attending school to ensure proper class placement. The scheduled date for each student to attend is listed by grade and time on the next page. All students must check-in at the gym on their designated date and time. Students will move through several stations on the Enochs campus to complete the SOAR process.

- **COMPUTER CHECK-OUT**

Each freshman and new MCS student will receive a computer device. Continuing students will exchange their current device with a new one. The device and its components are the sole property of Modesto City Schools and for educational purposes only. Like textbooks, students are responsible for their device if it is lost, stolen or damaged. However, parents/guardians may purchase optional annual limited technology coverage for \$20 per device. The optional coverage is purchased in the Student Activities office with **cash or credit only**.

- **IMMUNIZATIONS**

Modesto City Schools has a strict “**no shots, no school**” policy. Incoming ninth grade students and new students are required to have several immunizations. Please read the health information letter on our website to determine if your child will require updated or additional shots.

- **SCHOOL PICTURES**

All students are required to have a picture taken at SOAR. **The School Dress Code will be enforced** as this is the yearbook and I.D. photo. To purchase a picture package, please go to the Shoob Photography website at [www.shoobphoto.com/](http://www.shoobphoto.com/)

- **STUDENT I.D. CARDS**

I.D. cards are free to students and will be distributed immediately after a photo is taken.

- **P.E. CLOTHES & SPIRIT WEAR**

P.E. clothes may be purchased in the Student Activities office during SOAR or at the Enochs webstore, for \$25 for both shirt & shorts. Class shirts for \$10 and Senior sweatshirts for \$20, will be available for pre-order only during SOAR. All other spirit wear will be available beginning August 9<sup>th</sup> in the student store or online at <https://EaglesStudentStore.MySchoolCentral.com>. Spirit Wear is worn on Friday’s by students and staff alike. The student store accepts cash, check or credit card (except for the optional limited liability insurance).

- **STUDENT ATHLETES**

Online registration is now open for the 2021-2022 school year. All athletes must have their online sports packet via Sports Net at <https://sportsnethost.com/mcs-enochs/index.php?page=sign-in> complete, as well as, a sports physical dated after June 15, 2021 before they start practice. - **YEARBOOKS**

Yearbooks will be on sale for the discounted price of \$75 at SOAR in the Student Activities office, July 28<sup>th</sup> - August 6<sup>th</sup> only. The price will increase to \$80 on August 9<sup>th</sup> through quarter one and then increase by \$5 each quarter thereafter. After March 15, 2022 the cost will be \$95. Online orders will go live beginning September 1<sup>st</sup> at [www.yearbookordercenter.com](http://www.yearbookordercenter.com). Senior portrait information is posted online on the school website and at [www.wingspanyearbook.weebly.com](http://www.wingspanyearbook.weebly.com). Watch for other school mailings this summer as well!

- **DEBTS**

**Financial obligations must be settled at Enochs High School PRIOR to SOAR.** If you owe a debt for lost or damaged textbooks or library books, please come to the Enochs library to resolve those debts **before** SOAR. The library will be open all summer, Monday – Friday, 7:30am-3:00pm. For more info, please call 209-574-8633. To resolve other school debts, please contact our Bookkeeper at 209-574-8634 when our offices re-open on July 26<sup>th</sup>.

- **LOCKERS and TEXTBOOKS**

All students will be assigned individual textbook lockers. We do not recommend sharing lockers with another student as students who choose to share lockers often lose their textbooks at \$80-120 per book. **Students are financially responsible for lost textbooks.**

The locker number and combination will be printed on each student's individual schedule and should be kept private. Students will check out textbooks for most classes during SOAR.

- **LINK CREW (Freshmen Only)** Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will meet in the gym for orientation and are linked up in small groups of 8-10 with student mentors who are members of the junior or senior classes. The small groups will navigate SOAR together to complete the process for all freshmen. These mentors also help to bridge the gap for freshmen throughout the school year. Freshman, please arrive to school for SOAR at your start time listed on the previous page.
- **HEARING CHECK (Sophomores Only)**  
All 10<sup>th</sup> graders will have their hearing checked during SOAR. There will be a hearing station (mobile unit) located in between the boy's locker room and the gym. 10<sup>th</sup> grade students who miss the testing, will be pulled out of class for a make-up day in September.
- **PARKING PERMITS**  
All student drivers must always have an Enochs parking permit in view from the front windshield of their car while parked on campus during school hours. The initial parking permit is free and requires a completed form available online on the Enochs website, <https://enochs.mcs4kids.com>, under the supervision tab. Student Parking Permission slips must be signed and submitted to the Supervision office as the final step to receive a parking permit. Parking citations will be issued for students who do not display their permits as noted above as well as other parking violations. Students with questions or without computer access may come to the Supervision office for assistance in the application process.
- **SCHEDULES (Class schedules will be distributed after students have completed all SOAR stations)**
  - Please follow the guidelines below to request a schedule change.
  - The counselors will be available on a walk-in basis for High Priority requests during the week of SOAR.
  - Low Priority requests will be reviewed by the counselors after the first week of school.
