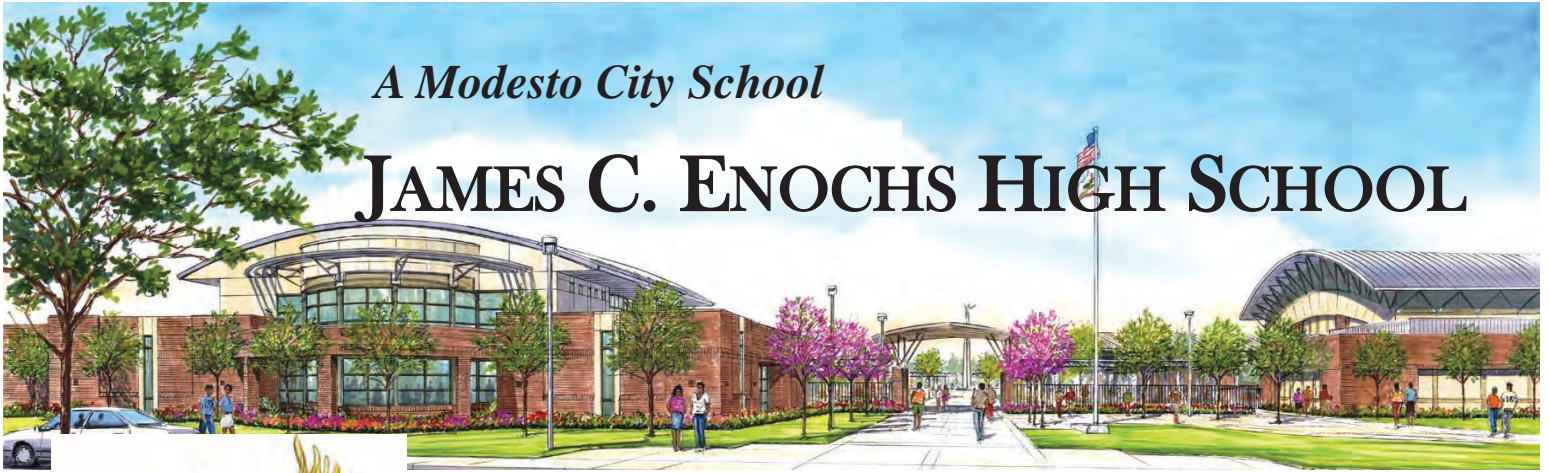

Covid Update

In the spring of 2020, our school along with most across the nation, had to shut down and complete the remainder of the year in distance learning. Students did receive letter grades for their spring 2020 semester coursework. We reopened the school in a hybrid setting in March of 2021. The vast majority of our seniors have been unable to take the SAT/ACT due to test centers cancelling tests within a 100 mile radius. Our students do not have the means to fly to other states to take this test. For the fall of 2021, our campus fully reopened to in-person learning. Because of state bill AB 104, students will have the option to take P/NP grades for the 20-21 school year. All sports and extracurricular activities are scheduled to start for Fall 21.

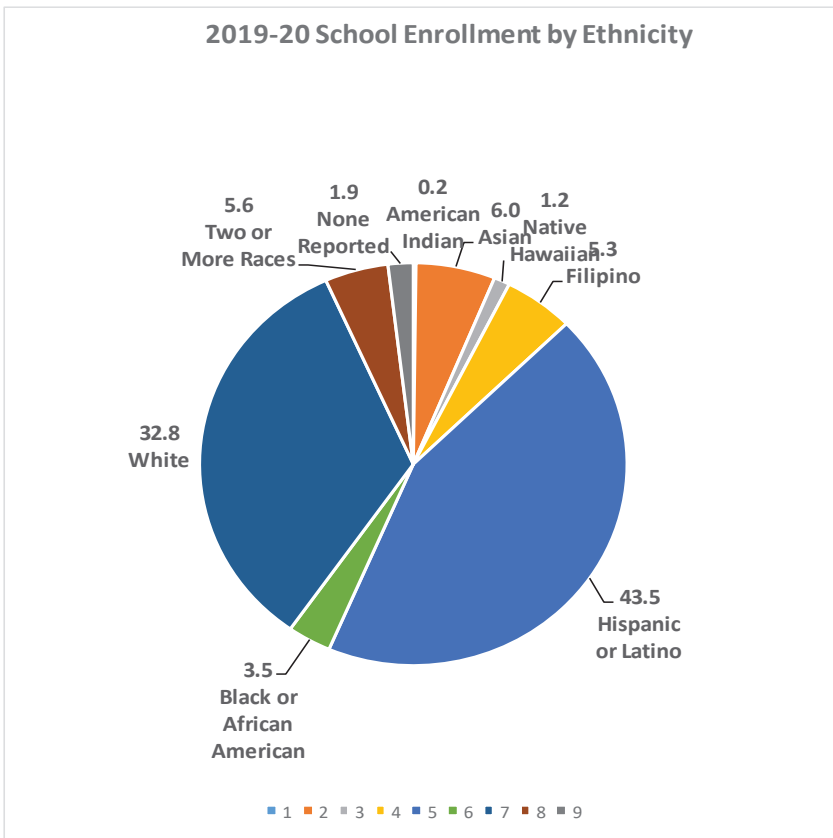

James C. Enochs High School was established on August 28, 2006 and is one of seven comprehensive high schools in the Modesto City School District. The majority of our 2,422 students in grades 9-12, reside in the northeast section of Modesto. Our goal for the students at Enochs High School is to develop successful students by providing top quality instruction within a safe, responsible, respectful culture. Enochs is located in the heart of the Central Valley in northern California. Agribusiness is the most prevalent industry in the area. Enochs has 106 certificated staff members, of those, 15 have a Master's Degree and 1 has a Doctorate degree. Our student to counselor ratio was reduced this year to 450-1 and we also employ a full-time college counselor who assists students in meeting their college and career goals.

Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment

For the Smarter Balanced state test which is taken in the junior year, 74.4% of Enochs students met or exceeded the standards for English Language Arts. In Mathematics, 43.4% of our students met or exceeded the standards set by the state of California. We were the highest performing high school in our district for the fifth year.

GRADING SYSTEM AND SCHEDULING

Enochs operates on a seven period 50 minute day, with one lunch period. Students may opt for a zero or an eighth period class from limited offerings including Spanish, marching band, jazz band, P.E., or leadership classes. The grading system for all classes is based on a five step scale: A-Outstanding, B-Above Average, C-Average, D-Below Average, F-Failing.

CLASS RANK

Our students are ranked by decile instead of number rank. Additionally the top 5% of students are identified on the transcript. Senior unweighted rank is determined by the cumulative unweighted GPA that is based on grades 9-11 and all classes including P.E. Weighted class rank is determined by the weighted GPA that is based on grades 9-11, and all classes including P.E., with an extra point for honors and AP courses in which the student earned grades of A, B, or C.

College Acceptance and Matriculation Class of 2021

68% of the class of 2021 responded to the survey and plans to pursue post secondary training at four-year or two-year colleges and universities, **30%** will attend four-year universities, **38%** will attend two-year colleges. This is the lowest response to the senior survey that can be attributed to Covid and online learning. Normally we have about **80-85%** of our students pursuing post-secondary education.
