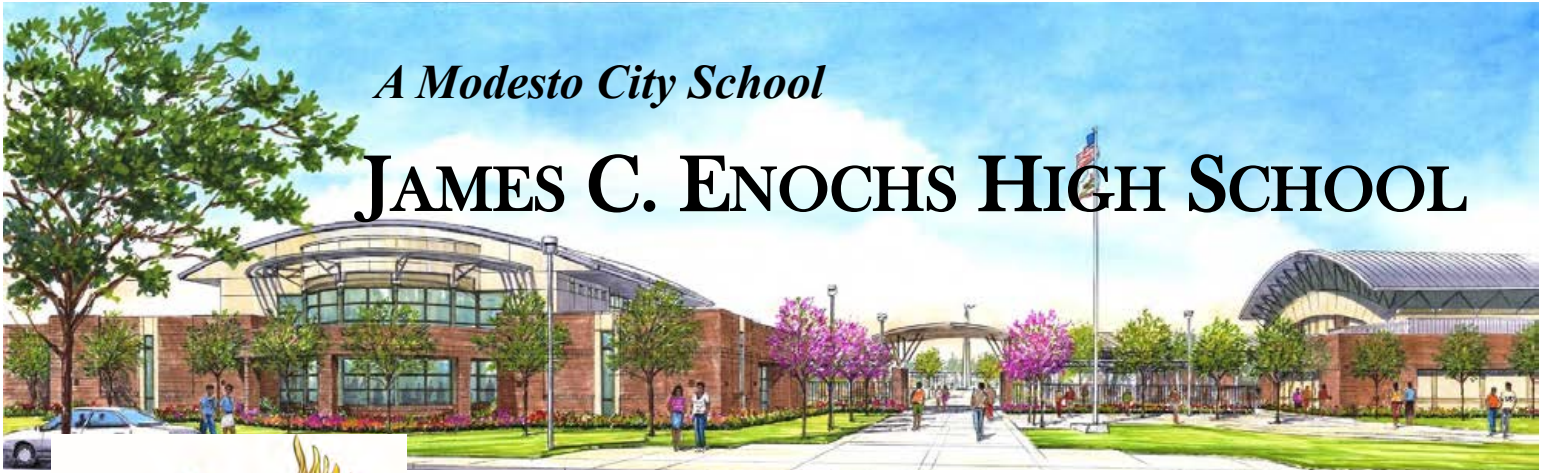

## Covid Update

In the spring of 2020, our school along with most across the nation, had to shut down and complete the remainder of the year in distance learning. Students did receive letter grades for their spring semester coursework. The vast majority of our seniors have been unable to take the SAT/ACT due to test centers being closed within a 100 mile radius. Our students do not have the means to fly to other states to take this test. For the fall of 2020, our campus remains closed and we continue to teach in a distance learning format. Students will receive letter grades for the fall semester. All sports and extracurricular activities have been cancelled with the hope to return in December.

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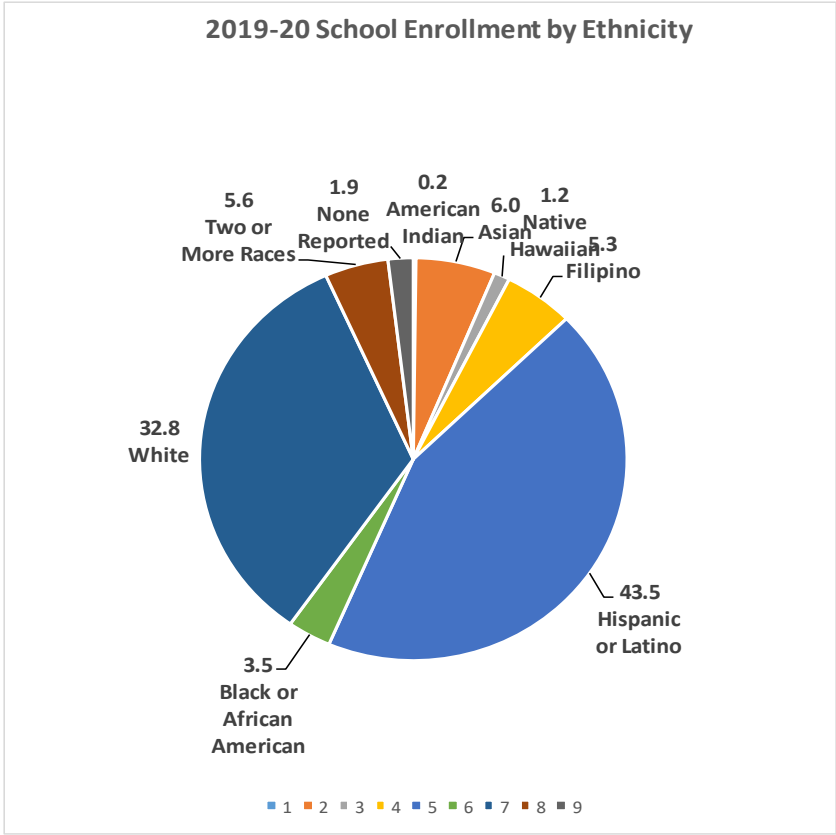
James C. Enochs High School was established on August 28, 2006 and is one of seven comprehensive high schools in the Modesto City School District. The majority of our 2,427 students in grades 9-12, reside in the northeast section of Modesto. Our goal for the students at Enochs High School is to develop successful students by providing top quality instruction within a safe, responsible, respectful culture. Enochs is located in the heart of the Central Valley in northern California. Agribusiness is the most prevalent industry in the area. Enochs has 106 certificated staff members, of those, 15 have a Master's Degree and 1 has a Doctorate degree. Our student to counselor ratio is 650-1 and we also employ a full-time college counselor who assists students in meeting their college and career goals.

## Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment

For the Smarter Balanced state test which is taken in the junior year, 74.4% of Enochs students met or exceeded the standards for English Language Arts. In Mathematics, 43.4% of our students met or exceeded the standards set by the state of California. We were the highest performing high school in our district for the fifth year.

### GRADING SYSTEM AND SCHEDULING

Typically, Enochs operates on a seven period 50 minute day, with one lunch period. Students may opt for a zero or an eighth period class from limited offerings including computer literacy, marching band, jazz band, P.E., or leadership classes. The grading system for all classes is based on a five step scale: A-Outstanding, B-Above Average, C-Average, D-Below Average, F-Failing. Due to Covid this year, we are doing four days of 80 minute blocks and one day of each class consisting of 25 minute periods.

### **CLASS RANK**

As of the 2018 school year, our students are ranked by decile instead of number rank. Additionally the top 5% of students are identified on the transcript. Senior un-weighted rank is determined by the cumulative unweighted GPA that is based on grades 9-11 and all classes including P.E. Weighted class rank is determined by the weighted GPA that is based on grades 9-11, and all classes including P.E., with an extra point for honors and AP courses in which the student earned grades of A, B, or C.
