Dear Parent / Guardian:

Your child has the opportunity to recover lost credits by attending Extended Summer School. If your child chooses to participate, he or she must attend every class on time, bring necessary materials, and complete all assignments. Course ballot is available on the school website or Schoology.

Regular attendance is extremely important. Students will be dropped on the 9th hour of absence; there are no excused absences in ESS (Extended Summer School). Work must be completed in a timely manner and turned in on the due date. Students who fail to complete coursework may be dropped from the class.

Students will be dropped from the class for any of the following reasons:

- 9 hours of absence; they will be dropped on the 9th hour*
- Not making adequate progress in the course.

Students attending an ESS course must abide by the above attendance regulations until the course is completed and an Early Release Form has been signed by their teacher and parent notified.

Please note that Extended Summer School classes are not a “quick and easy” way to earn credits. Students may have homework and reading assignments outside of class. If you are taking an ESS course, you must complete your Internet Safety Tutorial & Agreement and login BEFORE attending class. This can be obtained with the help of your school’s Librarian.

Attendance for Extended Summer School is taken every session. There are **NO EXCUSED ABSENCES for ESS*

Class Times: 3:30 -6:00 p.m.*

Students may attend Summer School and Extended Summer School for credit recovery. Courses are delivered in a blended model with the classroom teacher and online using FLVS curriculum. Online courses may not meet some college entrance requirements and may not be accepted by the NCAA Clearinghouse for intercollegiate athletics.
